A Summer Conversation

I can go into the Mid-continent library anytime I want (during business hours) and take out a book. I have borrowing privileges.

I can go to our health club and swim or play racquetball or sit in the sauna. I have membership privileges.

I can go online to Amazon.com, watch movies and buy merchandise -- with free shipping! I have Amazon Prime privileges.

I bet you can tick off a number of privileges that you enjoy in your weekly life.

But then there are other privileges that accrue to me simply because I have white skin. And I don't think of those benefits, because they flow to me constantly. The privilege of not being tracked through a department store when I shop. The privilege of getting just a warning from a police officer even after I admitted that I was probably going a few miles over the speed limit. The privilege of feeling welcome pretty much everywhere I go.

I want to invite you to a summer conversation about this issue of white privilege. You may be still wondering what it is exactly. Or you may feel as though your life doesn't feel particularly privileged. But this topic of white privilege, I believe, is at the core of our national struggle on race. I'm still coming to terms with my own privilege.



Our summer conversation will be low key. In the church parlor, or, if the weather cooperates, on the "porch" off the front of the sanctuary. And I'll provide the lemonade.

A tool that we'll use to stimulate our conversation is a book I've mentioned before, "Waking Up White" by Debby Irving. I have six copies (\$10 each), or you can pick it up at Amazon for \$18 if you have Prime privileges!

So come and share in the conversation. You can join in whether or not you have read the book. We'll engage different topics at each gathering, and move along as it suits us. Some conversations are at 1:00 p.m., others at 7:00 p.m. Here's the suggested schedule. Plug in when it works for you!

These are just reminders and a couple suggestions on how you can help some hard working, caring and loving people who have been called to serve us all.
