Dear BRPC Family,

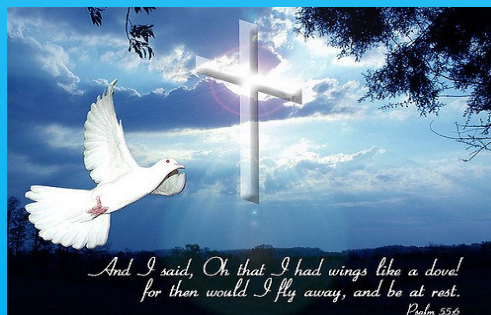
